# Yarra Valley Water: Procurement planning, sourcing and contract management on one platform

Yarra Valley Water (YVW) services 1.9 million people and more than 50,000 businesses across a 4,000-kilometre area of outer Melbourne, from Wallan in the north to Warburton in the east. Located in Mitcham, Victoria, YVW has approximately 700 employees.

YVW buys bulk water from Melbourne Water for distribution to customers. They remove and treat sewage, most of which is transferred to Melbourne Water's treatment plants. The rest is treated at their ten regional plants, where they also recycle water for use in homes, sports fields and public spaces.

Since 2019, YVW has been a member of Social Traders and has developed a social procurement strategy, which includes aims, targets, staff capability development, and how to identify opportunities and work with certified social enterprises.

#### The challenge

Yarra Valley Water's half a billion dollar annual procurement spend was not being managed consistently. Two different systems were in place for its two largest business groups to plan procurement and manage sourcing activity, while the other four groups followed manual processes.

An in-house application was used to manually record the signed paper contracts provided by the various groups. This caused the following issues:

Incomplete – Many executed contracts were only kept in paper versions, and a significant number were not registered in the centralised system. Filing of the digital versions of the contracts could not be enforced.


Inaccurate – The process contained inaccuracies as it relied on each procurement and contract manager to manually enter relevant information.



Little operational value – Although expiry dates could be captured and contracts due to expire could be flagged, there was no description of the services or works provided, no ability to search the content of the contracts, nor any means to manage the performance and various contract stages.

Manual controls - By relying on manual controls, the correct procedures could easily be bypassed or ignored and there were no systemic controls in place for contract deviations.

The solution was to deploy an integrated procurement planning, sourcing and contracts platform to over 350 users.



## Digitised procurement process according to procedures

The solution from VendorPanel was configured to Yarra Valley Water's processes with input from representatives of every business group. This allowed the organisation's procurement planning, go-to-market and contracting activities to be automated in a systematic and transparent manner.
